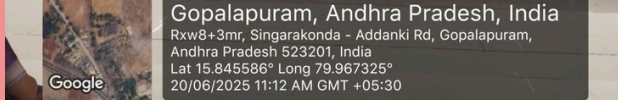

Dr. Pradeep Madamanchi Delivers Insightful Lecture on Environmental Principles and SDGs

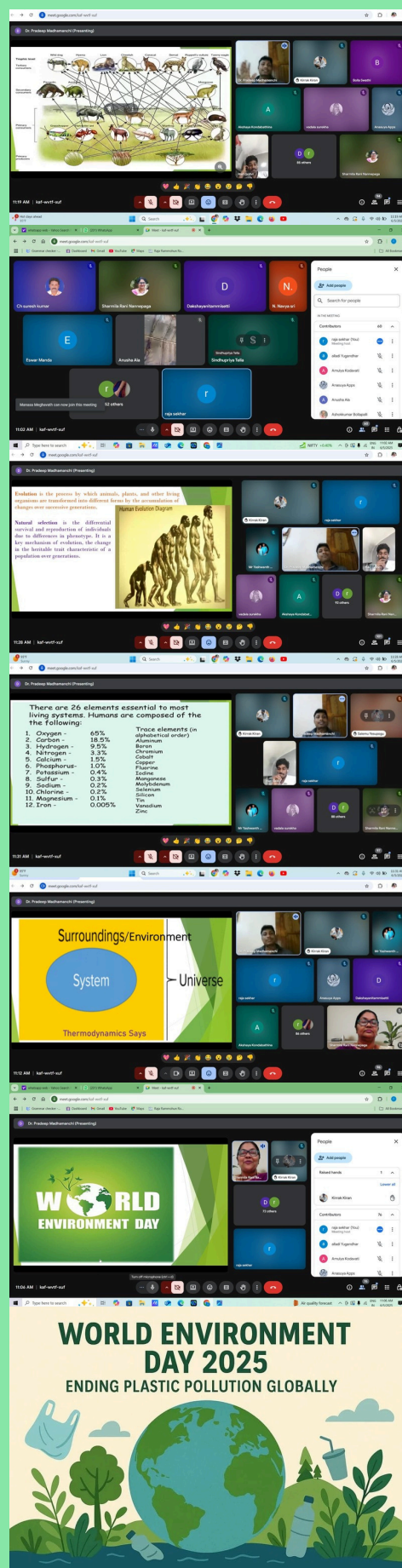
