NSS Special Camp Organized by KRKGDC, Addanki from December 1 to 7

Addanki, December 7, 2025:

The NSS Units I & II of Sri Katta Ramakoteswara Rao Government Degree College (KRKGDC), Addanki, successfully organized a seven-day NSS Special Camp from December 1st to 7th, 2025, with the objective of community development, social awareness, and personality development of student volunteers.

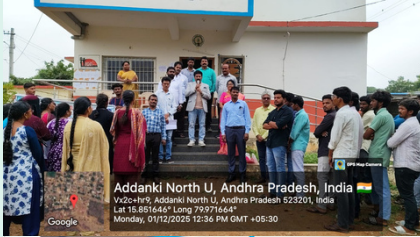

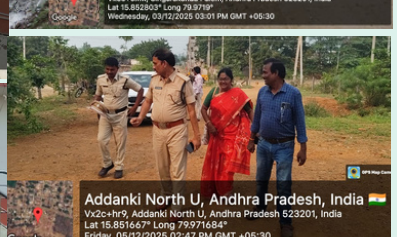

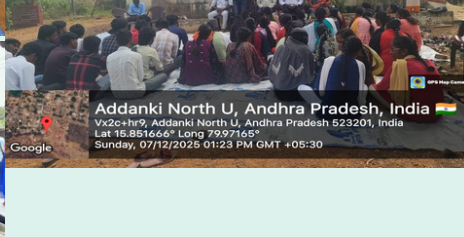

Botany Students Undertake Educational Field Trip to Laxmi Kamala Nursery

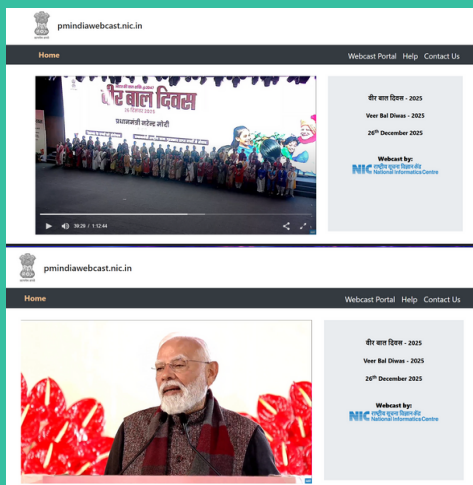
Addanki, December 17, 2025:

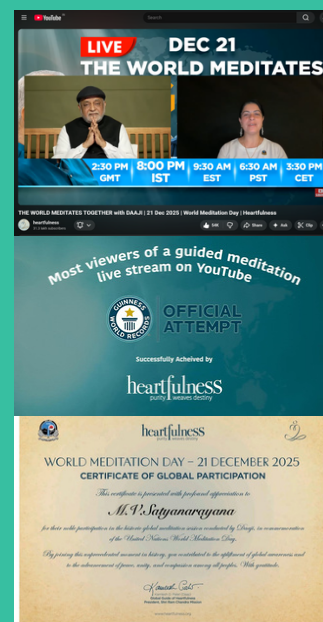


Addanki, December 29, 2025:
