K.R.K. Government Degree College, Addanki, celebrated the 150th year of the national song Vande Mataram

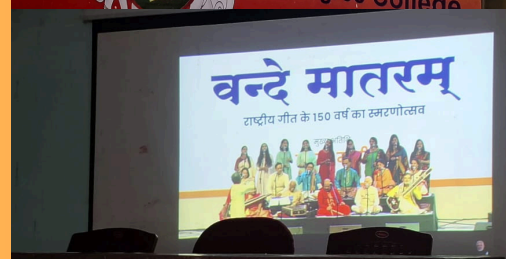
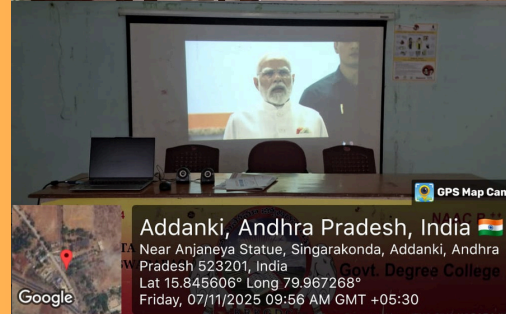

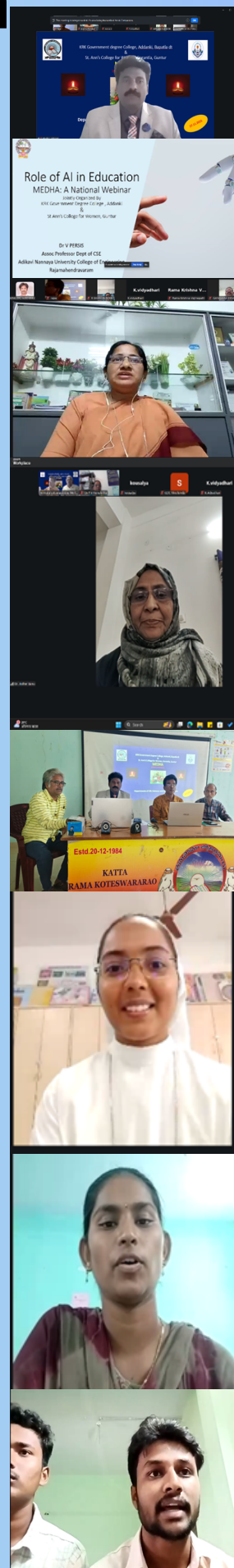

NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK CELEBRATIONS AT K.R.K. GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE, ADDANKI

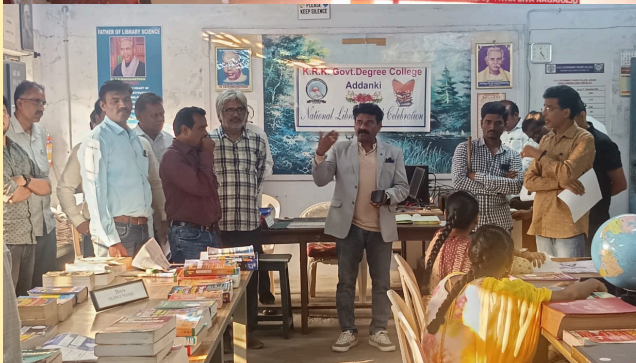
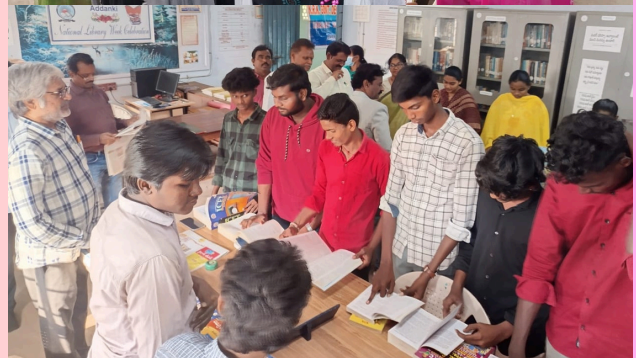
